Minutes of the meetings held on 06 May 2019 and 16 May 2019 were proposed a correct record RA all in favour

### **Matters from the Minutes:**

Highways – still temporary 30 mph signs at Mawbray, but a permanent 30mph sign has been erected at the junction of Jericho/Edderside/Newcowper clerk to contact Highways about this sign  
Brookside Farm – land to road belongs to Brookside Farm, they are not cutting the grass, (contractor contacted clerk when were stopped cutting) this could restrict visibility onto the B5300 contact Highways  
Mrs Stevens filled in and signed Register of Disclosable and Pecuniary Interest and other Registerable Interest Form

Community pub – public buy shares then can find match funding and other grants. To set up an online forum

Parish Council have sent concerns about the access road to Licencing and Highways

Local residents have sent their own concerns

We await replies from Allerdale Licencing and CCC Highways – Parish Council have not been contacted with any plans for the new festival site. The new Solfest 2019 site map had been difficult for local residents to view not published on public web site

Chairman had received an e-mail from a resident of Mawbray concerned about the saplings growing near the bridge in Mawbray nearest the B5300 Clerk to contact CCC Highways asking for a risk assessment to be done – could these trees cause damage to the bridge in future proposed LS all in favour
