Mawbray Defibrillator:

Barbara Stephens contacted Parish Council – the overhead light in the telephone box (defibrillator) has stopped working (SR) contacted Mark Eve (Electrical) to have a look, will decide what is needed and agree if reasonable to go ahead with the work

Small Grant Funding:

Food Cumberland Partnership, have small grants of £150.00 available to Community Groups, Schools, Parish Councils, to organise a Harvest Fest event this autumn (LS) to pass on information to School

Holme St Cuthbert Defibrillator:

Clerk to source funding via Cumbria Community Foundation (Hellrigg) for a replacement defibrillator at Holme St Cuthbert, now unable to get replacement parts to keep operational, will price new equipment from the same company has Mawbray defibrillator – Community Heartbeat Trust

Rosa Regosa:

(SD) spoke to representatives of SCNL who were spraying the Rosa Regosa on the Mawbray Banks, these were bushes that had been pulled out and not taken away, but had been allowed to regrow, was not happy this area is used by walkers and dog walkers

Cumberland Hyper Fast Broadband Event:

(LS) and (JanC) both went on the Teams Event link, Project Gigabit and HyperfastGB Information would fast be out of date, listened to complaints about different providers, proposed providers, the noncommunication when putting in infrastructure either underground or on poles. CALC will give the opportunity to watch the presentation

Coastal Erosion:

(JohnC) asked about the erosion at Old Kiln, Dubmill, it was last year when (LS) had a meeting with Mark Fryer Leader of Cumberland Council at Dubmill, he had said about monitoring and would keep in touch with the Parish Council via monthly call (JohnC) has seen equipment at Allonby measuring wave movement (LS) to contact Mark Fryer, for any updated information

B5301:

All Councillors concerned about number, size and weight of traffic using the B5301 through the Parish also it would be used has a diversion route when the B5300 coastal road is closed. Clerk to write to Amber Sykes Highways, Kevin Thurlow Local Councillor and Denise Rollo Councillor with portfolio for Highways
